Saint Name Project

Parents, to make your child's selection of a saint name a family project, we want you to do the following with your child and have him/her bring it to the atrium session to share. Your child's project will also be on display at the church on the weekend of Confirmation (TBA).

In choosing a saint, please do some research with your child, discussing the different characteristics of the saint. Remember that the saints are guides and companions for us. By praying to and studying their lives, they help us to see how everyday people like us, through grace, overcame their imperfections, leading them into a life of holiness.

Steps for your child:

- Saint's Name: _____
- Find out as much as you can about the Saint you chose
- Find articles, images, or items that represent different aspects of your saint's life.
- Arrange articles, images, and items in a diorama or on a poster. Include the saint's name.
- For example: St. Francis of Assisi
 - White doves
 - Pictures of him or a prayer card
 - Animals
 - Armor of a knight
 - Sign of creation
 - Sandals
 - San Damiano Cross
- Please make sure the items/articles/images are secured to the box or the poster as they will be on display.



**The project should be completed and brought to your child's atrium session
between February 1 and March 30, 2017**

Required dress for Confirmation/Eucharist

BOYS Dress pants, Kakis are fine (No jeans) and white shirt. Tie and or jacket are optional.

GIRLS White dress, (No gloves or spaghetti straps or bare shoulders). Veil or crown of flowers is optional.

Remember: They will be wearing the white garment from First Confession which they will embroidery a cross on during the retreat. For girls if you want to match some lace or trim on the edges of the white garment it is fine. (No other embellishments please)

Just a reminder; Please try to keep the focus on the gift of Eucharist and not on what their wearing.
